

July 1994 NCS May 1994 video lottery terminals are judged unconstitutional by state, vote was 4 to 1 against. They are judged as games of skill and not a chance lottery game anymore.

Video lottery started in S.D. 1989 will be up for vote in Nov. 1994 to amend wording in state constitution to allow.

gaming legalized 11-1-89 blackjack and poker only live games allowed All gaming to be located in 3 block stretch of Main Street - 6 square block section

By law - The word "casino" cannot be used by anyone in town. All places to be called "gaming" or "gambling" "halls" or "saloons"

Gaming regulated as 30 devices per building and 15 devices per sales tax license.
