### Imperial to merge with Thunderbird Gaming

Plans were announced in late April for International Thunderbird Gaming Corporation to merge with the Imperial Hotel and Casino. Imperial Gaming Corporation, which purchased the Imperial in 1992, would retain 6 percent of the ownership in the casino, turning the other 94 percent into the hands of Thunderbird. Currently, International Thunderbird already owns casinos in Central America and has no immediate plans for the Imperial, although expansion plans may figure in the future.
