The patriotic name of Uncle Sam's Casino has been applied to Cripple Creek's latest gaming endeavor at 251 East Bennett, formerly known as Lucky Lola's Casino and located across from The Midnight Rose.

Owned by the Southwest Casino and Hotel Corporation of Minnesota, Uncle Sam's owners hope to incorporate a touch of Las Vegas at the new casino, which will feature over 100 devices spread over two floors and an upscale restaurant. Live entertainment, which is currently a rare occurrence in town, is also planned.

Southwest Casino is said to have a proven track record, having previously opened casinos on Indian reservations in Oklahoma and Texas. If all goes well, Uncle Sam's will open in April.
